Ask the Investigators

Q: What are my options to receive monogenic diabetes testing?

A: There are two routes to consider when pursuing monogenic diabetes testing for yourself or family members. Commercial-based or clinical-based genetic testing is completed at a lab with some insurance companies partially or fully covering costs. Research-based genetic testing is completed through our research study, without involving your insurance company, and is free-of-charge.
